TIME OF FIRING: Competitors should report to their assigned firing positions by 9:45 AM. Safety briefing and announcements to follow. **Firing will commence at 10 AM Bristol, Indiana time.**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual.

CMP ID NUMBER: All competitors who have a CMP number must put their CMP ID number on their card.

RULES: Current CMP Pistol Rules will govern.

CLASSIFICATION: All competitors will be classified according to the CMP Classification System in individual matches. Competitors who do not have a CMP classification may elect to compete with their current NRA classification. (Rule 3.11.4 f).

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of two (2) dollars will be charged for each challenge (Rule 3.10.5).

ENTRIES: Individual - Entries in individual matches will be made not later than 9:30 the morning of the match accompanied by check or money order payable to **SJV Pistol**.

Entries Close - Individual match entries must be received not later than 9:30 AM the date of the match.

Entries Limited - Entries are limited to 80 competitors. Persons making entry within the time limit who cannot be accepted will be notified and their fees returned. Preference is given to competitors shooting the entire program.

Post Entries - post entries will be accepted up to the range capacity provided extra relays are not required.

Competitors may choose to shoot .22 only for the whole 2700. If you plan to do that please let me know when you send your entry.

FEES: Individual Match Fee 30.00 for 2700 or 10.00 per gun (.22, CF, .45)
 Juniors: Juniors pay reduced match fee of \$10, and are not eligible for cash awards.

GRAND AGGREGATE

Match # 16- an aggregate of Matches 1-15.

AWARD SCHEDULE: Six or more competitors will constitute a class. If there are fewer than 6 entries in a class, there will be NO AWARDS provided in that class. Competitors will be combined with the next higher class. Competitors of lower classifications will not be combined with the High Master Class. If fewer than 6 entries in the High Master or Master Class, they will compete for open awards only.
