BRISTOL REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

DATE: June 29 & 30, 2024

LOCATION: Chief Wa-Ke'-De Range, 16067 State Rd. 120, Bristol, IN.

SPONSOR: St. Joseph Valley Rifle and Pistol Association, Inc.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual.

NOTE: CMP registration is encouraged, but not required to compete in CMP tournaments.

CMP ID NUMBER: All competitors who have a CMP number must put their number on their card.

RULES: Current CMP Pistol Rules will govern.

CLASSIFICATION: All competitors will be classified according to the CMP Classification System in individual matches. Competitors who do not have a CMP classification may elect to compete with their current NRA Classification (Rule 3.11.6). Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master class if they do not have a pistol classification (CMP or NRA). (Rule 3.11.7).

TEAMS: A team will consist of four (4) firing members, one substitute, a captain and/or coach, and will represent a club (Rule 2.6.8), a law enforcement agency (Rule 2.7.9), a Regular Service, National Guard or Reserve Unit (Rule 2.7.1,3,2), or a State Association (Rule 2.7.5). The team captain or coach may be firing members of the team.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of three (3) dollars will be charged for each Challenge (Rule 3.10.5).

ENTRIES: Individual – Entries in individual matches may be made online at <https://sjvrpa.wildapricot.org/> no later than 8am the morning of the match accompanied by payment to SJVRP.

Teams – Team entries must be made the Team Captain in person prior to the start of firing of the team match.

Entries Close – Individual match entries must be received no later than the Monday preceding the date of the Regional. Team entries may be made any time prior to the start of firing the team match.

Entries Limited – Entries are limited to 80 competitors. Persons making entry within the time limit who cannot be accepted will be notified and their fees returned. Preferences is given to any competitor shooting the entire program.

Post Entries – post entries will be accepted up to range capacity provided extra relays are not required. Competitors may choose to shoot .22 only for the whole 2700. If you plan to do so, please specify this when submitting your entry.
